



*St. Joseph's is excited to announce a parish-wide project for the installation of twelve new stained glass windows.*

### WHY STAINED GLASS?

From the earliest days of wall paintings in the Roman catacombs, Christians have been involved in intentionally beautifying their places of worship.

This is because proclaiming the beauty of creation, no less than the truth in words and goodness through a holy life, is a fundamental aspect of the Good News of salvation.

Communicating the transcendent love of God through beauty may be especially important in our modern society whose public culture is dominated by this-worldly, money-driven and materialistic attitudes.

Pope Francis has described the need for churches to be "oases of beauty" that help persons encounter with God, and Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI repeatedly emphasizes how beauty must play a central role in the New Evangelization.

### Why these windows?

The new windows are designed to tell the story of salvation in a beautiful simplicity.

They show us its key moments, from the beginning at creation up to the witness of the prophets, and in anticipating Christ, complement and enrich the meanings behind the windows already there.

They are also originals that have been designed by local artists specifically for St. Joseph's and will therefore be unique to us.

### About the artists

John and Laura Gilroy AMGP work out of a small studio in Vancouver and specialize in traditional and contemporary glass painting.

Trained as apprentices in one of England's oldest studios founded in 1788, they have been creating stained glass since 1985.

They employ traditional methods from start to finish, designing and painting each window by hand, and all of their projects are uniquely designed for each client.

### How can I help?

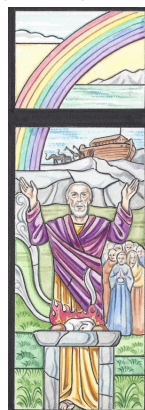
Each of the twelve windows, approximately 5' x 22''' including its, creation, and installation will cost \$10,725.00 plus GST.
