Let us continue to give thanks to the Lord for the many blessings of faith, family and treasure that he has bestowed on us.

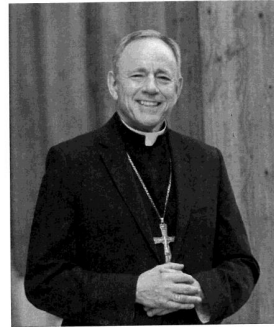
